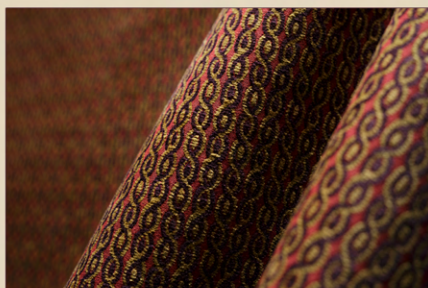


## Orietta

This small-scale figured chenille had as its inspiration a fisherman's belt woven of rope displayed at the Benaki Museum in Athens.



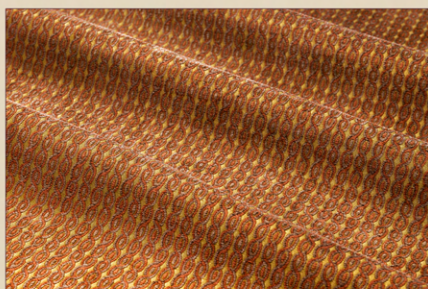

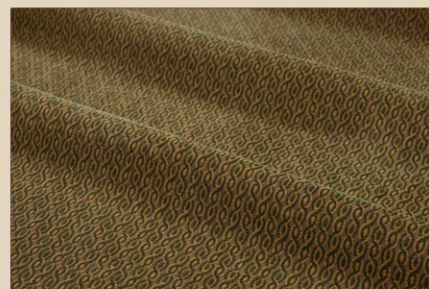
